



## PETITION

To the Honourable the Speaker and Members of the Legislative Assembly of the Parliament of Victoria now assembled.

THE HUMBLE PETITION OF THE UNDERSIGNED ELECTORS OF THE STATE OF VICTORIA RESPECTFULLY SHOWETH:

## THAT THE UNDERSIGNED ELECTORS :

- (a) DEPLORE THE CONTINUING INFLUENCE OF ALCOHOL AS MAJOR CONTRIBUTING FACTOR AND CAUSE OF DEATH AND INJURY ON AUSTRALIAN ROADS,
- (b) BELIEVE THAT DRINKING DRIVERS DEPRIVE MOTORISTS OF THE RIGHT TO SAFE TRANSPORT FOR THEMSELVES AND FAMILIES BY ENDANGERING THE LIFE AND LIMB OF ALL WHO USE THE ROADS,
- (c) BELIEVE THAT THE DRINKING MOTORIST INFRINGES THE CIVIL LIBERTY OF THE MAJORITY OF THE COMMUNITY BY CAUSING AND CONTRIBUTING TO THE DEATH OF OVER 50 AUSTRALIANS EACH WEEK AND BEING A MAJOR CONTRIBUTING FACTOR IN THE DEATH AND INJURY OF NEARLY ONE MILLION AUSTRALIANS IN THE PAST 20 YEARS,

YOUR PETITIONERS THEREFORE REQUEST THE GOVERNMENT TO INTRODUCE AT THE FORTHCOMING SESSION OF PARLIAMENT LEGISLATION FOR RANDOM BREATH TESTS AND TO ENSURE THAT SUCH LEGISLATION IS STRICTLY ENFORÇED.
